ELIGIBILITY:

This show is for original artwork. Reproductions of such artwork may constitute no more than 50% of the work exhibited by the artist. **Artwork displayed should be a result of the artistic category in which you are applying.** The committee will reserve the right to prohibit the display of any work it deems inappropriate for a family show.

MEDIA CATEGORIES:

Oils, acrylics, watercolor, graphics, drawing, mixed media, pastel, photography, jewelry, sculpture, pottery and hand blown glass. No molds, kits or crafts.

APPLICATION & FEES:

ALL 2017 RETURNING ARTISTS

Artists are required to submit an application and a check for \$80 for each panel or table. *No jury fee is required.* You will be included in the 2018 roster of participating artists and no acceptance notification will be sent to you.

ALL NEW ARTISTS

Artists are required to submit the following:

- Mid-Winter Art Fair application
- Self-addressed stamped envelope
- \$15 nonrefundable jury
- Separate check for \$80 for each panel or table
- Four clear images of your recent and representative work for jurying.

Artwork submitted for jurying must be the original creation of the artist. To be accepted into the show your work must meet the standards set by the Jurying Committee and will be evaluated for Originality, Quality and Appearance. If your application is accepted, you will be notified by mail or email and if your application is not accepted, your check will be returned to you.

DIGITAL ENTRIES: JPEG images on a CD. CDs will not be returned. File size should be no smaller than 900 pixels in the longest dimension. Digital entries may also be emailed to ladnarspangler@gmail.com. (Please indicate MWAFF 2018 in Subject line). Name your images "LAST NAME, First Initial, Name of Painting.jpg."

IMPORTANT DATES:

October 31, 2017 - Postmark deadline for application and fees along with 4 JPEG's if new artist.

December 15, 2017 - Notification of Acceptance to new artists applying for the first time to this show.

January 7, 2018 - Cancellation/Refund deadline. No application fees will be refunded after this date.

Set-up hours - Thursday, February, 9 and Friday, February 10, 2017. (See General Information)

Show hours - Friday, February, 9, 2018 - Show hours are 10 am - 9 pm

Saturday, February 10, 2018 - Show hours are 10 am - 9 pm

Sunday, February 11, 2018 - Show hours are noon to 5:30 pm

EXHIBIT:

Panel size is 6'x8' and must be covered with professional quality materials, edges must be hemmed, and (Propanels are allowed but must stay within the perimeter of the panel size). Use only blunt "S" hooks for hanging on show-provided panels. Tables are 3'x8' and must be covered with fabric. Display shelving or pedestal boxes may be placed on top of the tables for three dimensional works or you may bring your own display area not to exceed 5'x8'. Only one print bin or portfolio per panel is allowed and may not extend into the aisle. There will be assigned areas for coats, supplies, etc. (Artists provide all electrical supplies). Lights must be limited to 100 watts per panel or table. Only the medium for which you have been juried can be exhibited.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Set up: Artists can set up on Thursday night, February 8, from 9 pm – midnight or Friday morning, February 9, from 7 am - 10 am. **The Ward Parkway Mall will not allow any set up during the day on Thursday, February 8 nor can you start setting up before 9 pm Thursday evening.**

Postcards: All participants are encouraged to send Mid-Winter invitation postcards to their mailing lists. Please indicate the number of postcards needed and post-card pick-up location. Locations are listed on the application portion returned to MWAFA. You will be notified when the postcards are ready for pick-up.

Taxes: Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Missouri Sales Tax and reporting it directly to the Missouri Department of Revenue. You can register for sales tax id # at: online-federal-tax-id-application.com/Missouri... The Jackson County sales tax is 8.48%.

Awards: On Friday judges will select artists for awards. Please indicate on the application form the medium in which you wish to be judged. Judges begin viewing around noon and cash awards are presented that same day.

Art works are the responsibility of participating artists only; neither the Mid-Winter Art Association nor the Ward Parkway Center may be held responsible for loss or damage or personal injury. Art must be in good taste as determined by Mid-Winter Art Fair Board and Ward Parkway. The MWAFA Board reserves the right to remove any art of an exhibitor whose work varies widely from previous year or submitted JPEGs and that does not comply with the rules of the show.

All participating artists will receive additional instructions about parking, available storage, etc. in January.
